



WOODWARD CANYON



Woodward Canyon Winery was established in 1981 by Rick Small and his wife, Darcey Fugman-Small. The winery was named for the canyon where Rick's family farmed for multiple generations and where the Woodward Canyon Estate Vineyard is now located. Woodward Canyon was the second winery in the Walla Walla Valley, and the Smalls were instrumental in the process of obtaining federal approval of the Walla Walla Valley Appellation in 1984.

2024 WOODWARD CANYON FACTSHEET

Name: The Estate Vineyard is located in Woodward Canyon, approximately 3 ½ miles northwest of the winery off of Woodward Canyon Road.

Winery Location: Washington State's Walla Walla Valley Appellation. Approximately 13 miles west of the city of Walla Walla on Old Highway 12 in the community of Lowden.

Owners: Rick Small, Darcey Fugman-Small, Jordan Small, Sager Small and Kevin Mott.

Winemaker: Kevin Mott.

Founding Date: 1981. 2nd winery in Walla Walla Valley.

Tasting Room: 1870's farmhouse which has been moved twice. Served as the residence for the Superintendent and teacher of the Lowden schoolhouse next door. Acquired and refurbished as the tasting room in 2000. The Reserve House was constructed on the property in 2008 and houses space for private tastings and winemaker dinners. Originally the family farm shops. Additional buildings have been added.

Production Facility: Originally the family farm shops. Additional buildings have been added.

Brands: Woodward Canyon Winery, began producing Woodward Canyon wines in 1981.

Production: Around 10,000 cases total. 50% - 60% produced from our own acreage.

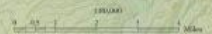

Estate Vineyard: Woodward Canyon Estate Vineyard: Walla Walla Valley Appellation, 35 acres. The Estate Vineyard is certified as Salmon Safe.

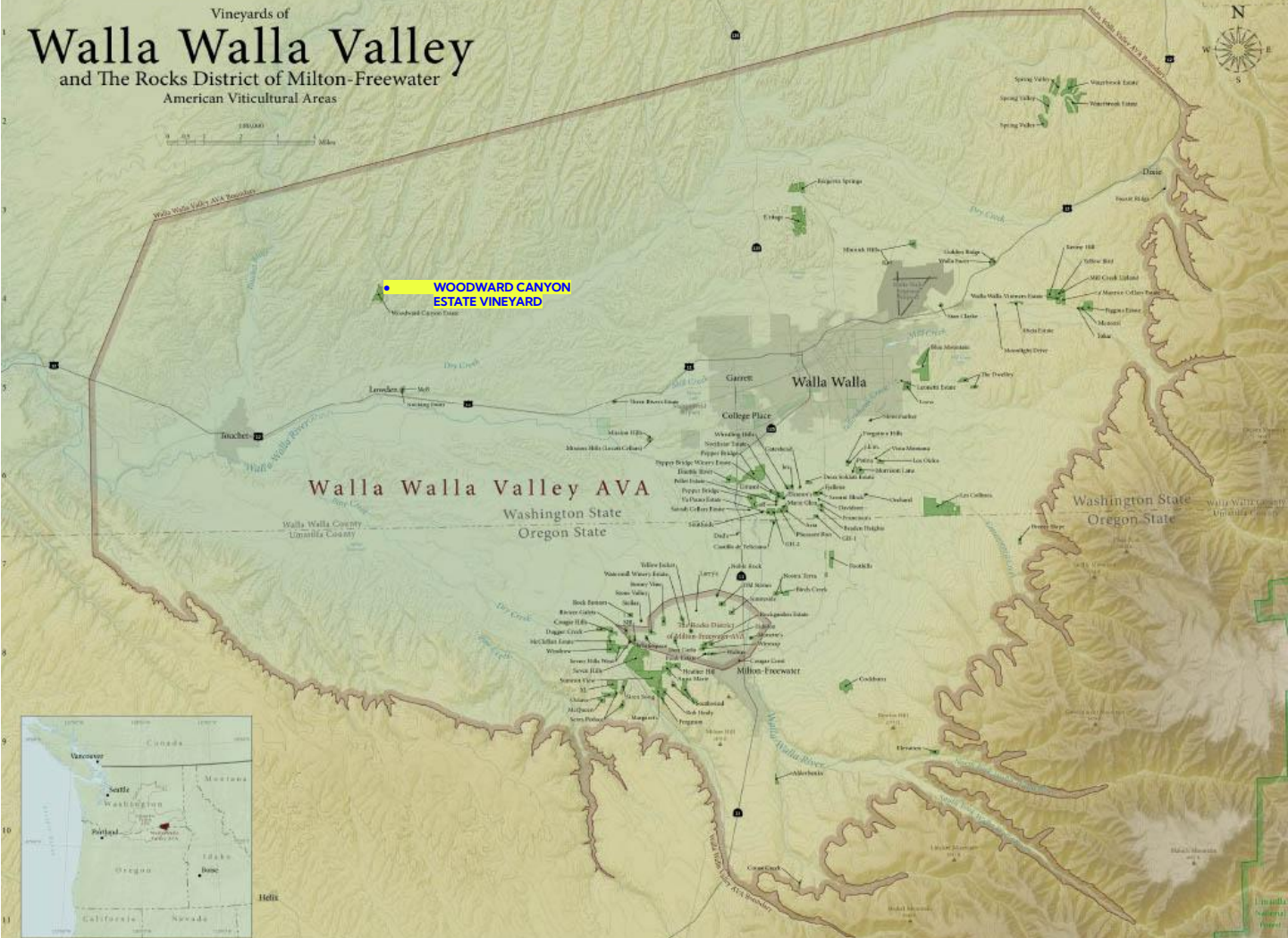

2023 Woodward Canyon Washington State Chardonnay



Inspired by the Grand Cru's of Burgundy, chardonnay was the first wine founder, Rick Small, made as a home winemaker. It was also the first varietal planted on the Woodward Canyon Estate Vineyard. This wine is a blend of two different blocks from our Estate Vineyard – our southeast-facing “old vines” block planted in 1978 and a newer, north-facing block planted in 2011. Produced and bottled at Woodward Canyon Winery.

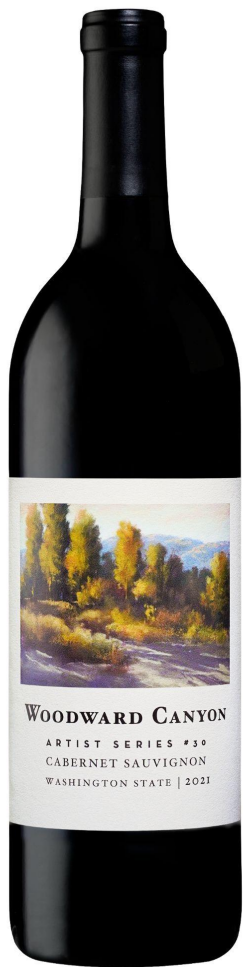

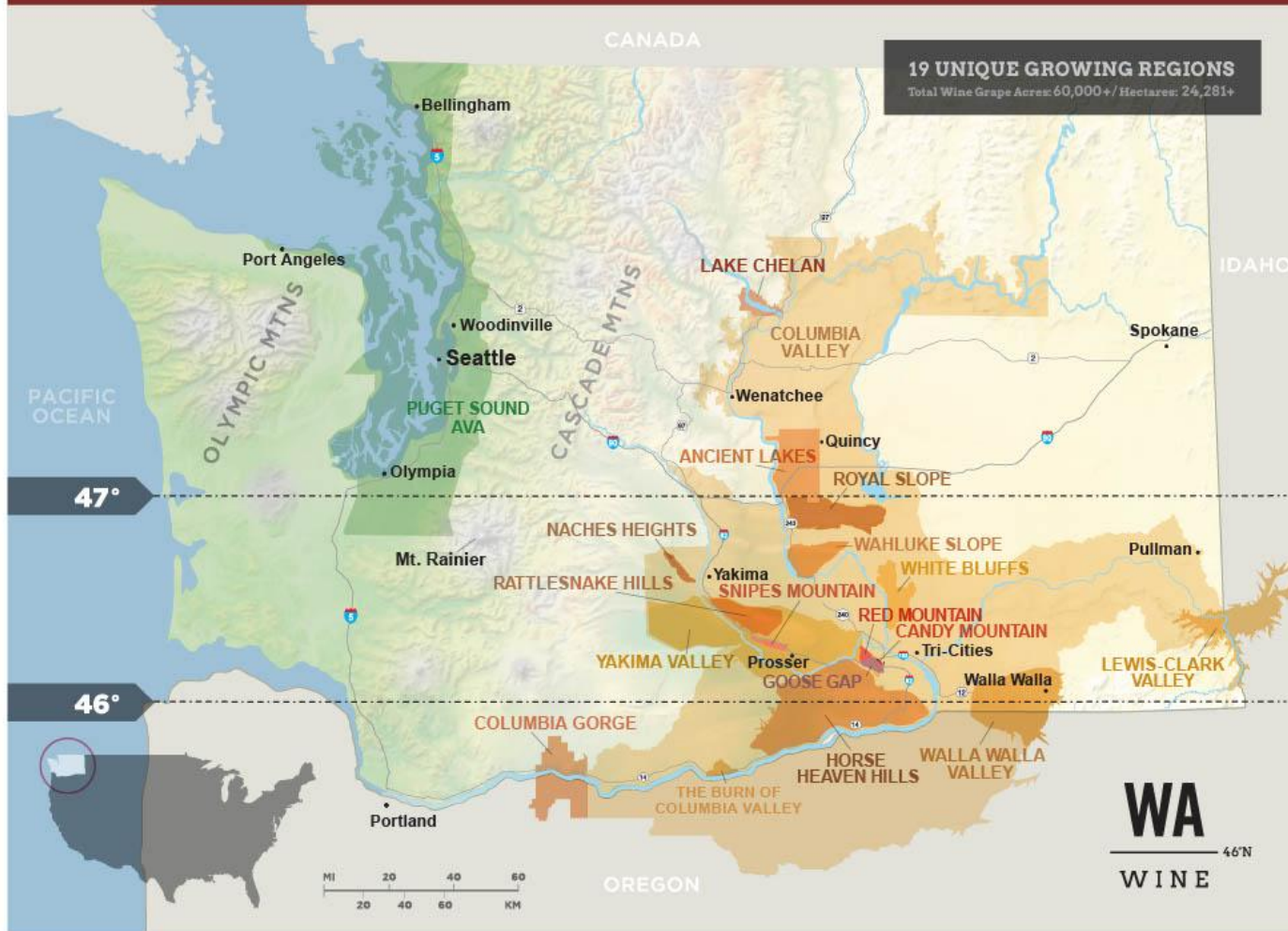
2021 Artist Series Washington State Cabernet

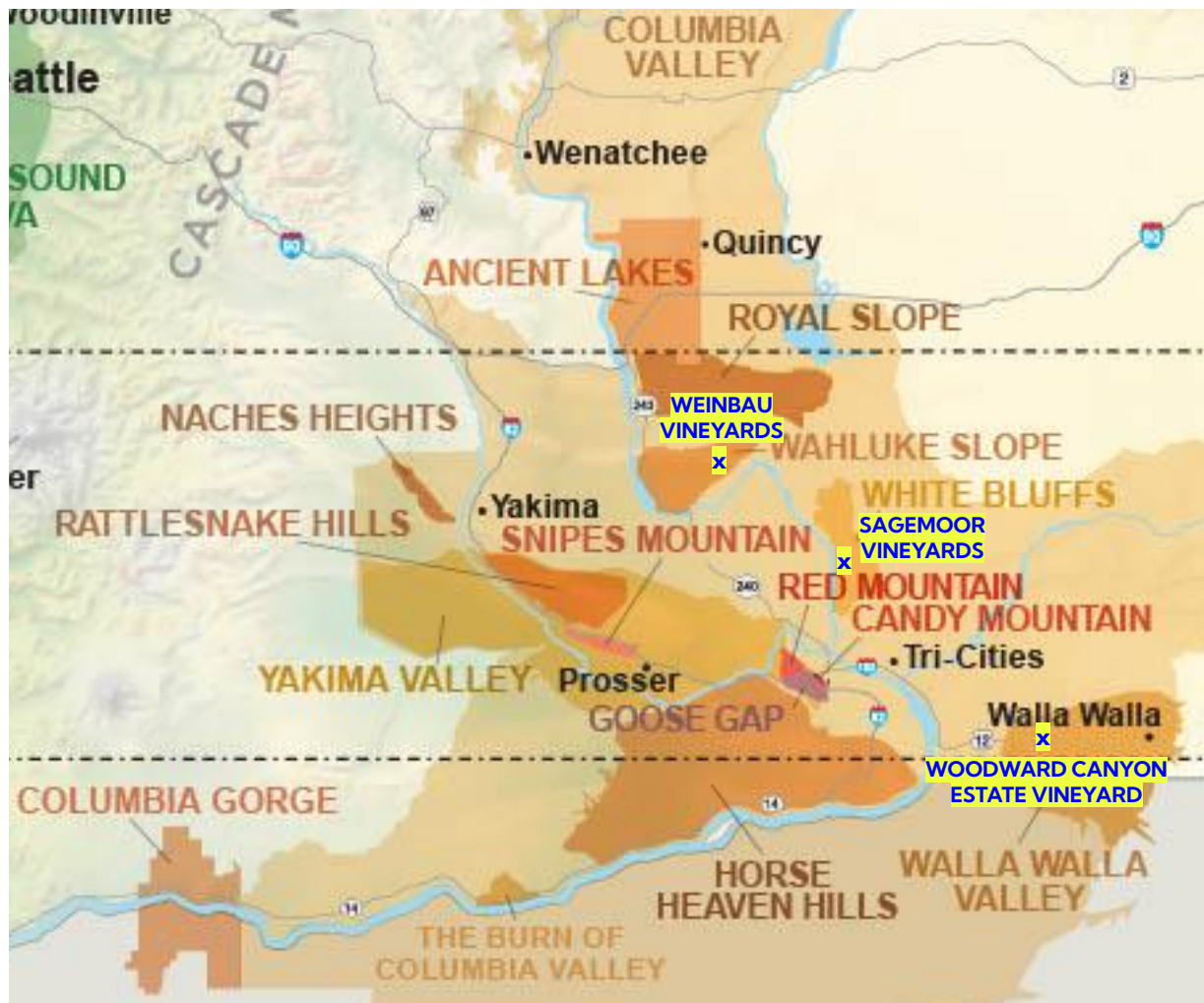

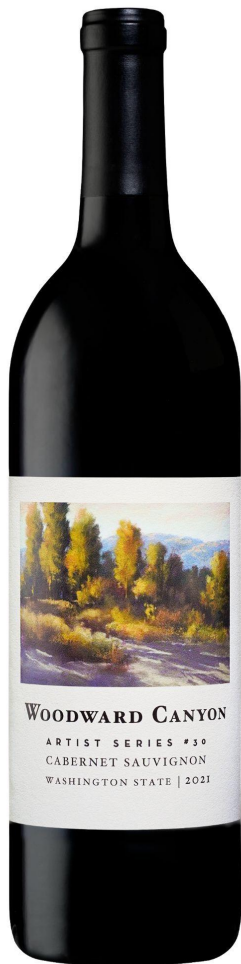

Sagemoor Vineyard

Founded in 1968 through the vision of Alec Bayless, Sagemoor Vineyards was a pioneering effort that helped establish the Washington State wine industry. Its early vineyards are among the oldest large-scale plantings of vinifera grapes in the State. Rick began using Sagemoor fruit in his home winemaking days and we continue to use it today. A significant number of 1972 plantings are still producing our highly acclaimed Old Vines Cabernet Sauvignon sourced from specific rows in Blocks 3 and 9.

Weinbau Vineyard

Weinbau has a view of the Rattlesnake Mountains to the south, and the Saddle Mountains to the north. The land slopes gently south, with elevation ranging from 710–950 feet. Weinbau is a warm site with excellent air drainage, and soil is dominated by Kennewick silt loam with 2–5% slope. The consistency of soil type shows up in vine growth and subsequently in the wines.

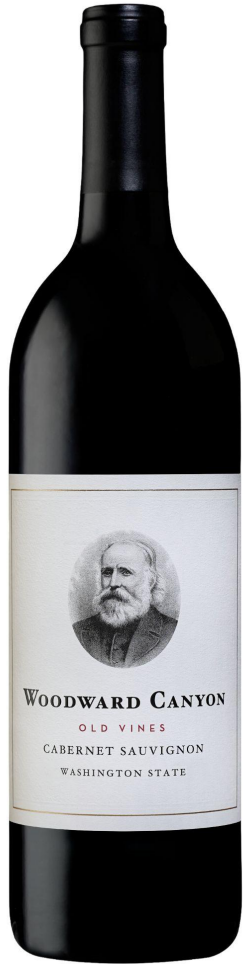

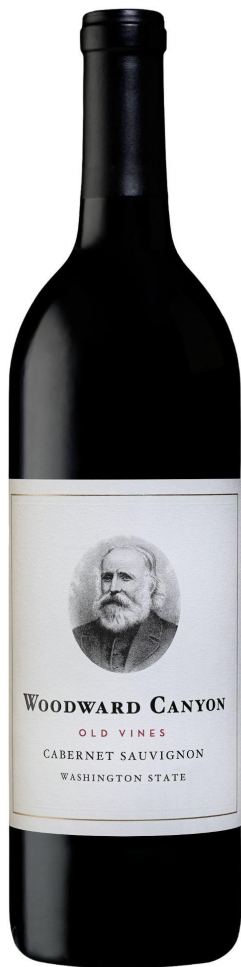


2021 "Old Vines" Washington State Cabernet Sauvignon

The Old Vines Cabernet Sauvignon (originally Dedication Series) has been in production since the bonding of the winery in 1981. Primary sourcing has always come from some of the oldest cabernet blocks and the most highly acclaimed sites in the state. The 1987 vintage was the first Washington wine to be on Wine Spectator's Top 10 list.

Woodward Canyon Estate Vineyard



Rick planted the first of thirty-five acres of the Woodward Canyon Estate Vineyard in 1977 on his family's dryland wheat ranch. The hillside vineyard now includes cabernet sauvignon, chardonnay, merlot, cabernet franc, sauvignon blanc and syrah. Several more acres of green belts that support native species such as western juniper, ponderosa pine, western sagebrush, arrowleaf balsamroot, and perennial wildflowers. The Smalls are also experimenting with organic and regenerative farming practices. The soil composition is Ritzville silt loam over fractured basalt, slope 15-18%, 750-850 ft. elevation. All grapes are Salmon Safe certified. Managed in house by vineyard manager Sager Small & foreman Juan Esparza.
